### Alexander R. Vaccaro, M.D, Ph.D, F.A.C.S

Alexander Vaccaro graduated in 1992 as an Orthopaedic Surgeon at Thomas Jefferson and then completed a Spine Fellowship at the University of San Diego. In 2007, Professor Vaccaro earned a PhD in the field of Spinal Trauma. In 2015, Prof. Vaccaro received his MBA (Master of Business Administration) from Temple University's Fox School of Business in Philadelphia, PA and graduated with honors. He served as the president of Rothman Orthopaedics since 2014 and is the Richard H. Rothman Professor and Chairman in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery and Professor of Neurosurgery at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Professor Vaccaro dedicated his entire curriculum to the evolution of orthopaedic and spine surgery and published over 900 peer-reviewed and 200 non-peer reviewed articles. He was involved in over 370 book chapters and is the editor of over 60 textbooks. His contributions to the field of spine surgery are numerous, including world-wide used classification of spinal trauma and several surgical techniques. He is recipient of the Leon Wiltse award given for excellence in leadership and clinical research for spine care by the North American Spine Society (NASS) and is the past President of Cervical Spine Research Society (CSRS), the American Spinal Injury Association and the Association for Collaborative Spine Research. He is currently member of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) Board of Directors.

We are very honored to welcome Professor Vaccaro, a world-renowned spinal surgeon and educator, as our 2023 Reinhold Ganz lecturer.
